

George II William Kent Mirror

A carved and gilt-wood mirror in the manner of William Kent and the Palladian style. The rectangular looking glass within a compound moulded frame has outset corners, flanked by trailing bellflowers, decorated with Greek key pattern, blind fretwork and with leaf carved paterae at each corner. The architectural broken pediment is carved with egg-and-dart mouldings centred by an acanthus leaf wrapped cartouche.
