

Booker Mirror

In the manner of John and Francis Booker of architectural form with a broken pediment centred by a foliate carved urn over a rectangular plate flanked by fluted columns.

These mirrors are similar in style to a pair carved by the famous Dublin firm of Francis and John Booker circa 1750, Glin Castle, Co. Limerick. See *The Knight of Glin and James Peill, Irish Furniture*, Yale University Press, 2007, P 140-141.
